**BANQUET REPORT: SOUTHERN WEST  
VIRGINIA FRIENDS OF NRA**

The Southern West Virginia Friends of NRA Committee held their 13<sup>th</sup> annual fundraising banquet on Saturday, September 20, 2014 at the Raleigh County Convention Center in Beckley. There were 200 participants at the banquet.

The 2015 banquet has already been scheduled for Saturday, September 12, 2015 again at the Convention Center.

For those of you who have never attended a FONRA banquet, you must try it sometime. We awarded over 20 guns to winners of games, raffles, drawings and in the live auction. There were items of interest for all members of the family from youth .22 rf rifles to jewelry to art work to tools in addition to multitude of firearms. All of it to raise money for NRA programs (non-political) across the state and across the country. 50% of the money raised stays in WV. Please plan on attending a banquet next year.

**Beckley Gun Club**

The Beckley Gun Club (Facebook, [www.beckleygunclub.com](http://www.beckleygunclub.com)) had very successful shooting season with six 3-Gun Matches; a USPSA match to benefit the Athens Volunteer Fire Department; the 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Coalfields Classic Glock Sport Shooting Foundation (GSSF) match; a West Virginia Troopers Association 3-Gun Match (LEO Only); and a traditional Conventional Pistol (Bullseye) Match.

The 3-gun matches drew as many as 65 competitors from WV, VA, KY, OH, PA & NC. 3-Gun is a fun, action packed match where you use a handgun, rifle and shotgun on paper and reactive targets. Fastest time with the least penalties (misses) wins.

The annual GSSF match is sponsored by Glock. This year over 2 days of shooting, 430+

matches were shot. This is one of the larger GSSF matches in the country. The only requirement is to use a Glock handgun. There are divisions for any Glock including the new M42 in .380 ACP.

The Beckley Gun Club offers NRA classes in First Steps Pistol and Refuse to be a Victim, along with advanced classes and NRA instructor training in several disciplines. Range Safety Officer training can be offered to any WVSRA member for only the cost of materials.

The Beckley Gun Club had a successful annual Media Day this past spring where we ask reporters from the local broadcast and print media to come to the range and learn about firearms and shooting. We encourage family participation from the media. This year we also invited Representative Shelley Moore Capito (now Senator Elect Capito).

We always strive to announce during our banquet that one half of all monies generated in the state comes back to the state to assist junior shooting programs and many other programs. The future of the shooting sports, hunting and responsible firearm ownership rests with our youth.



### **L & S INDOOR PISTOL RANGE YOUTH DAY**

L & S Indoor Pistol range had the privilege of hosting an NRA youth shooting sports day on Saturday, September 13, 2014 from 12 to 4 pm. The event was offered to children ages 7-18 with NRA instructors provided for individual, one-on-one, instruction. Volunteers from the local Seneca Trail Friends of NRA were present to promote their upcoming dinner and also provide additional instruction to junior shooters.

We began advertising a month prior to the event through social media and a local radio station. The shooting, supplies and safety equipment were completely free to all participants. The youth were offered a large variety of firearms to shoot... ie BB guns, air rifles, air handguns, a .22 LR handgun and a .22 LR Ruger 10/22.

We believe that this was a successful venture with about 25 juniors attending during the 4 hour span. We plan to offer the same type of event again in the spring of 2015. We are striving to encourage and educate the youth of today to enjoy shooting in a safe controlled environment.

The team finished 10<sup>th</sup> in the .22 Rimfire Match, 1<sup>st</sup> in the Centerfire Match, and 8<sup>th</sup> in the .45 Caliber Match for an Aggregate 1<sup>st</sup> place finish. The GOLD team also won this match in 2010 and placed third in 2011.

Also of note: SSG Sally Talbott and Alan Talbott placed in the President's 100 Pistol Match. SSG Sally Talbott and Thomas Allen won silver medals in the National Trophy Individual Pistol Match, while Alan Talbott and Lee Godbey won bronze medals in that event. #### Raffle at Annual Meeting

## 2014 WV STATE OUTDOOR PISTOL CHAMPIONSHIPS

The 2014 West Virginia State Outdoor Pistol Championships were again sponsored by Brassmasters and held at their Bullseye Range, Peeltree, WV, September 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup>. Perfect weather conditions prevailed over the two-day competition which consisted of a 2700 Bullseye Tournament, a Distinguished Revolver Match and EIC Service Pistol Match.

This event attracted competitors from New York, North Carolina, Ohio, Pennsylvania, and Canada and throughout West Virginia; with total entries at range capacity. The championship opened on Saturday morning's 1<sup>st</sup> Relay with Kimberly Hobart setting the bar very high for other competitors. The holder of 14 National Records and nine-time National Women's Champion posted an 880x33 in the .22 stage to clinch the .22 Aggregate Gold Medal. Not to be outdone and when asked after the .22 stage how he was shooting, Wes Fleming replied, "not too good, I'm getting beat by a girl." High Master Wes quickly zeroed in on the X and 10 rings in the Center-Fire and .45 Stages, posting an 864x32 and 868x33 respectively to take the Aggregate Gold Medals in both the CF and .45 stages. To put their accomplishments in proper perspective, both Kimberly and Wes "shot straight through" firing the full 2700 on Saturday along with three other competitors.

Sunday morning brought more beautiful weather and good scores, with High Master and North Carolinian Wes Fleming posting a 2605x98 to take the beautiful Mountaineer Open Winner Award along with \$150., followed by Master Shooter Sally Talbott taking the Gold Mountaineer Trophy as the 2014 WV Resident State Champion, with a score of 2533x72. High Woman winner was Kimberly Hobart, New Philadelphia, Ohio; High Senior was claimed by Mark Bentley of Barboursville, WV; Delores Williams of Summersville, WV won the Grand Senior Award and the State Champion Junior Gold Medal was won by accomplished junior rifle shooter competing in his first pistol tournament, Robert McClain of Walkersville, WV.

The Four-Man Team Matches resulted in a "sweep" by the Pennsylvania Gold Team, consisting of members Jeff Lloyd, Tom Mix, Steve Gibbons and Eugene Martin, posting a cumulative score for the .22, CF & .45 National Match Course

of 3344x90 to claim a "sweep" of the six other teams.

Saturday's .22, CF and Distinguished Revolver competitions culminated with a delicious catered dinner for all competitors, guests and volunteers. Sunday concluded the championship with an awards presentation by Gary Bailey, President of the West Virginia State Rifle and Pistol Association. In addition to their awards and medals, winners were also treated to a trip to the prize table to select their choice of prizes ranging from a spotting scope, range gear, brass and bullets, to \$50 gift cards. Door prize drawings were also held for all competitors, with winning ticket holders selecting their prize.



### Brassmasters – NSSF

Brassmasters was the recipient of one of only 30 Range Grants nationwide, from the National Shooting Sports Foundation's (NSSF) Steel Challenge. The Grant consisted of 12 Commercially produced, high quality, portable steel targets and stands to be used for NSSF Steel Challenge Events. The Steel Challenge Events were formerly known as the Ruger Steel Challenge Events. Its purpose is to introduce youth and adults with little or no experience an opportunity for exposure to the shooting sports by providing a steel challenge event using .22 Rimfire pistols and rifles. Competitors compete in separate classes according to skill level and equipment at a safe, properly managed, non-intimidating and welcoming learning environment that will hopefully, result in new converts to the shooting sports.

### WEST VIRGINIA DNR

A new electronic Game Checking System will be implemented on April 1, 2015. You must

have a new DNR ID Number (valid for your lifetime) to use the new electronic game check system.

Beginning April 1, 2015 you will be required to check your game by one of the following three methods:

1. **Internet** – Go on line to [www.wvhunt.com](http://www.wvhunt.com)
2. **Telephone** – Call 1-844-3521 (1-844-UCheck1)
3. **License Agent** – stop at a license agent. You will not have to bring the animal in with you.

**You must have a new DNR ID Number (valid for your lifetime) to use the electronic game check system.**

**License buyers:** When you buy a base license, you will be assigned a DNR ID Number which will be printed on your license.

**Non-licensed hunters:** If you are not required to buy a license (e.g., landowner, underage, senior citizens who turned 65 before 1/1/12, etc.), you may visit a license agent or log on to [www.wvhunt.com](http://www.wvhunt.com) after January 1, 2015 to obtain your DNR ID Number.

**Lifetime license holders:** If you have a lifetime license, you will already be in the system. To obtain your DNR ID Number, visit [www.wvhunt.com](http://www.wvhunt.com) or a license agent after January 1, 2015.

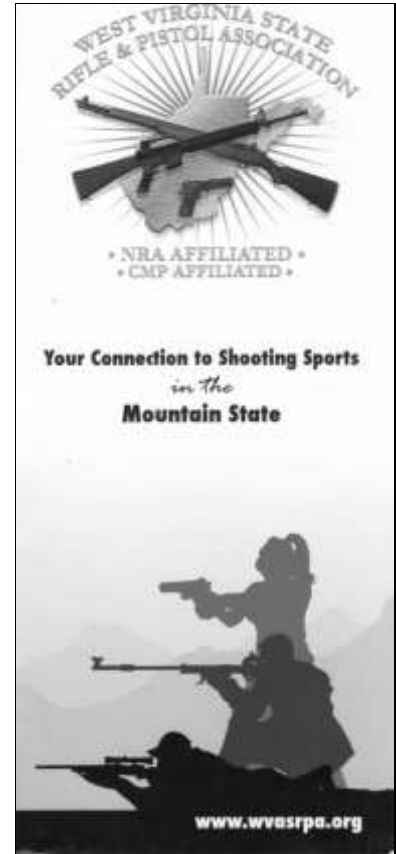
