**Little Kanawha Rifle Club Matches**

The Little Kanawha Rifle Club has set the match schedule for 2011. Our Groundhog matches will be held on the following dates: April 10, May 1, June 5 and 26, July 31, August 14, September 18, and a "Friends of NRA" benefit shoot in early October.

There are several rifle classes to suit about everyone: Hunter, Factory, Factory Custom, Custom and new classes for AR's and Junior Shooters (15 and under). Groundhog targets are at 100, 300, and 500 yards. Hunter Class, Juniors, and AR's will fire five rounds at 100 and 300 only. All other classes will fire 5 rounds at each 100, 300, and 500 yard targets. Shooters are allowed one sighter/fouling shot at the beginning of the 100 yard relay. There is an optional shot at an egg at 500 yards following the last relay. The range is open on Saturday prior to the match for practice. There is no practice on the day of the match. Entry fee is \$12 per gun and Juniors shoot free and coaching is allowed in this class.

Our range is located in Wirt County about 10 miles east of Mineral Wells in the Parkersburg area. To get to the range from Mineral Wells take Rt.14 toward Elizabeth approximately 9 miles to the Camp Barb Road. Turn left on Camp Barb and go 1/2 mile to Oak Hill Road. Turn right on Oak Hill and the range is on the right in another 1/2 mile.

Sanctioned IR 50-50 Benchrest matches for 22 rimfire rifles will be held at these two clubs located in the mid-Ohio Valley. Junior Smallbore Rifle Program**

The Junior Smallbore Rifle Program is a year round program. We practice outdoor from April to October and indoor from October to April. We compete year round at the local, state, and national level. In 2010 we had 46 shooters participate in the competitive program. Our two day Junior Camp was a success. We had 42 participants (29 male and 13 female). There is no cost to the junior shooter to participate in these programs.

This programs goals are: To enrich the heritage and sport of shooting for youth; To provide safe gun handling and fun while instructing the youth in the shooting sports; To develop a participants ability to become a successful competitive shooter as an individual and as a team member; To develop Leadership, Discipline, Concentration, Sportsmanship and Responsibility and To compete on the local, state and national level.

This program benefits the youth of our community, Scouting organizations, non- shooting parents and other interested participants with shooting instruction and gun handling safety, and prepare shooters for collegiate competition. The volunteer staff holds NRA certifications as: Training Counselors; Chief Range

Safety Officers; Range Safety Officers; Instructors and Coach.

In 2010 several of our shooters upgraded their NRA certification. They received recognition in local and NRA publications. We took 2 shooters to the National 3P Championship Match at Camp Perry, OH. There were 294 shooters participating in this event. We took 7 shooters to The National Prone Championship Match at Camp Perry, OH. There were 275 shooters participating in this event. Catherine Kauffelt was High Woman in two matches and High Collegiate in two matches. She qualified and shot in the Randle Match (top 10 women). She finished third in this match with a score of 400-26x. She won the 2<sup>nd</sup> place Collegiate Award. This was the first time to Camp Perry for 2 PCGC shooters and all achieved great experience and satisfaction from this event. WE had a very successful year of shooting and are looking forward to 2011.

### High Power Matches at White Horse

The 2011 shooting schedule reflects two rifle tournaments, the Regional Championship 1000-Point Aggregate to include 1000 yards on June 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>; and the West Virginia State Championship 800-Aggregate and 1000-Yard Championship on June 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>.

I'm sure the question will be asked, "Why are only two rifle matches scheduled". There are fixed costs to run a tournament. First, looking at the 2010 West Virginia State Championship, we only had 6 shooters attending. Secondly, only 38 shooters attended the Regional 1000-point Championship; of which 26 shooters were members of the U.S. Army and U.S.M.C. military teams from out of State, leaving only 12 civilian entries. The White Horse Center requests anyone with an answer to "why are there so few entries?"; please forward your thoughts and info to me, or call the range or the Board of Directors. The Board will gratefully make corrections to enable shooters to attend our tournament in greater numbers.

We learned that during the 2010 shooting season many ranges had a decrease in shooter entries. But the numbers of known rifle shooters within West Virginia, alone, often by-pass White Horse Center to shoot other tournaments. Is this a trend or something that we at White Horse Center need to correct? I have asked many shooters who regularly shoot at this range the very same question. Those competitors comment that the range is great to shoot on, all matches well managed (to include beginning on time and no match cancellations), range well maintained, and awards and scores posted promptly. Again anyone who may have a solution or input as to the low participation, I enthusiastically want to hear your thoughts. Our goal is to be "big and better". We Board members feel the problems from prior years have been corrected, but the 2010 shooting year did not respond to these corrections.

During 2010, visiting shooters' interests were not "over the course competition", but for longer range shooting at

600 and 1,000 yards. The current 2011 shooting schedule reflects the shooters' interest for prone shooting. Shooters' interests will be closely evaluated for 2012 season using comments and tournament attendance as a guide.

Again to all interested shooters, the White Horse Range Board of Directors requests your input to encourage more high power competition at White Horse Center. Our primary interest is to schedule more rifle matches based upon entries and enthusiasm.

A question about match entry funds was asked by a competitor, here is what happens with those fees. All of White Horse matches are run by volunteers. No money is paid to any member for their effort. All money minus tournament expenses goes in to the Center's general fund.
