2019 Ed Williams Memorial West Virginia State Precision Pistol Championships

Shooters from 10 States Participate In Annual Ed Williams Memorial West Virginia State Precision Pistol Championships

Competitors from throughout West Virginia were joined by shooters from Pennsylvania, New York, Maryland, Virginia, North Carolina, Georgia, Wisconsin, Idaho and Florida for this annual two day event held September 28th & 29th at the White Horse Center and sponsored by Brassmasters.

Temperatures hovering in the 90s, with high humidity both days of competition did not have an adverse affect on some excellent shooting. Some of the top Precision Pistol shooters in the country posted some impressive scores. Leading the way was two-time NRA National Champion and retired Marine shooter, Jonathan Shue of North Carolina. Shue outscored all other competitors in all three phases of the championship by posting an 875-49X in the .22 caliber phase; 877-33X in the center fire phase and 873-40X in the .45 caliber phase, for an aggregate score of 2625-122X, to take the Open Champion Trophy back to NC. In addition to the Open Winner Trophy, Jonathan won medals as the .22, center fire and .45 aggregate winner and two medals as a member of winning teams.

The headline of this article could have read “local shooter does well,” because that is what happened. Buckhannon native SFC Sally Talbott was crowned

the 2019 West Virginia State Champion. Although this was Sally’s second time in four years winning the state champion title, this time she did it with a break-thru score that landed her in the NRA’s prestigious 2600 club, with an aggregate score of 2602-101X. Sally said that she was very happy to become a member of the NRA’s 2600 club.

In achieving this shooting milestone and it was made sweeter by achieving it at her home range and with fellow competitors and friends that she had competed side-by-side with since she was a young girl. In addition to her state champion trophy, she also won two medals as a member of winning teams and as the High Military Shooter.

Camp Perry – National Pistol Matches

Mark Bentley, of Barboursville, the then current West Virginia Precision Pistol Champion, finished second in the Expert Class in the Center Fire Aggregate and second in the Expert Class in the .45 Caliber Aggregate at the National Precision Pistol Championships, held at Camp Perry, Ohio, July 8-12. In the Center Fire Matches, Bentley's scores of 181 in the Slow Fire Match, 287 in the National Match Course, 195 in the Time Fire Match and 196 in the Rapid Fire Match, produced an aggregate score of 859, which earned him the second place out of 159 Expert Class competitors. His score of 847 earned him the .45 Aggregate Second Place. Along the way, his score of 288 earned him First Place in the Expert Class in the .45 Caliber National Match course. Bentley is a proud holder of the Distinguished Pistol Shot badge, for Excellence in Competition, conferred on him by the Director of Civilian Marksmanship, whose office was created by act of Congress.

Pistol shooters from West Virginia fielded three teams at the National Matches. The West Virginia Green Team, consisting of Nathan Gunn of Spencer, Joe Robinson of Clarksburg, Zachary Bowman of Lost Creek and Al White of Buckhannon, won fourth place Sharpshooter team in the .22 Caliber Team match, second place Sharpshooter Team in the .45 caliber team event and First place Sharpshooter team in the Aggregate State Team competition.

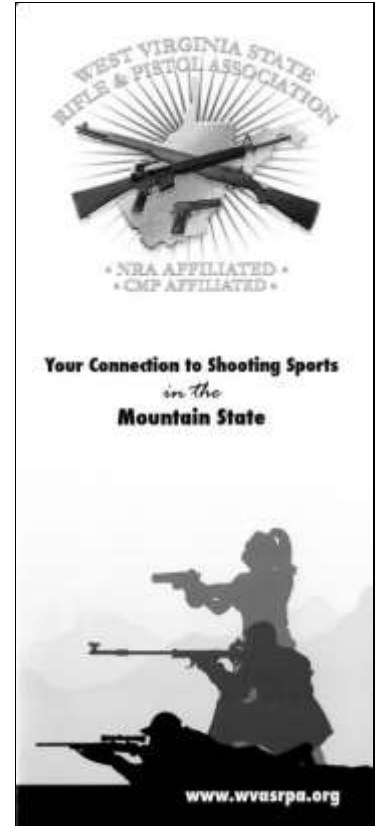
